

## *Some computer rules*

**rule # 1:**

Software with even more bugs which should not be published is called *alpha* or even (with more bugs) *pre-alpha*.

**rule # 9:**

Preview versions of software which you can't control with your input are called *demos*.

Conclusion: Windows<sup>TM</sup> is the *pre-alpha-beta-demo* of the *world-biggest-virus-worm-trojan*.
